Boarders

In order to keep all the horses living on the property on the same deworming schedule I will list when deworming is due in the newsletter. This will help to ensure that the medicine is as effective as possible if all the horses are being dewormed at the same time. If you will be giving your own dewormer I will need proof of deworming or I will administer the proper dewormer and you will be charged accordingly. All horses need to be dewormed the first week of September with Combo Care or Quest Plus.
